






Is your neighbourhood good for employment but bad for health?


All 32,844 neighbourhoods in England have been ranked on a range of deprivation topics. The most deprived neighbourhood in England has a rank of 1.

'Total deprivation' and 'overall deprivation' is the Index of Multiple Deprivation (IMD).






